**Gina:** Hello Renee, welcome to The Rise of the Feminine.

**Renee:** Hi there, I'm so glad to be here, honored. I've been loving your show and happy to help out anyway I can.

**Gina:** Thank you so much. That's great. I know you're in LA and I haven't been there for ages, I'm so looking forward to coming back there. I wanted to talk to you because I know your 25 years of experience in dating and relationships and we've just been speaking to Susie Heath and talking about relationships and marriages later in life. What can happen to a couple when that last child has left and the separation that can happen .... and I thought, well for our Country report, let's go to the states, let's talk to Renee and find out what's happening with American women. Are they happily married? Are they even married? What's happening in the dating scene?

**Renee:** Unfortunately, I would say that it's proven that **women are waiting statistically longer to get married** and then on top of that there's a 50-60% divorce rate in America right now, currently different states have bigger divorce rates like California where I am and I see a lot- *I am so sorry. It's my dog, I am so sorry.* He's barking about this and so are the women. The women are barking, why aren't there men that want to get married, the women seem to be very frustrated that the men haven't

reached a certain level of awareness of what women really want and I've been on a quest to **help the men understand the minds of women** but the women in America are so strong, they've become so strong like myself.

Those are the target market that I work with. **Strong, very dynamic businesswomen that are on a quest**, like I am to help people with love, they are doing careers that sometimes stop them from finding love because they want to **get to a certain level** and then they think once they reach a certain level of success that a man is just going to magically fly onto their porch and say, "I want to love you and take care of you." It's just not happening. The **men are sometimes intimidated by these women**.

**Gina:** How do men feel about success? Because in America you've got so much opportunity for women, there are a lot of women leaders, it seems to me that with the system that you have, especially there are many other countries that do support women having children and going back to work, you don't really have that in America. Do you find women making the choice between a fantastic career or having a family and how are men reacting to these strong successful women?

**Renee:** I have to tell you, what you just said is the key to this whole thing. I myself used to think, "**once I**". I call it the **once I syndrome**. Once I achieved a certain level of success that a man was going to be turned on to that and I had it in my mind that I couldn't work and have a love-life at the same time. When in reality, with the men that these dynamic women are attracted to usually are businessmen themselves, right.

**Gina:** Yeah.

**Renee:** The women are like, I'm at this level, **I want someone at my level**. The reason that those guys at that level get turned off by American women is because **they talk like men talk about their career** and men feel like they don't carve out time for love. The American women get mad when those dynamic men that we're all attracted to ... the alpha superman that's out there, that we go, I would love to meet someone like him, those men still want, they **still have imprints in their minds about what a wife would be like**. This is what I finally discovered and it's really- it's going to make women happy, I'm not here to depress them, I'm here to say, you need to be able to **switch off your wonder woman** and tune into that **feminine energy that men are dynamically attracted to**.

Then, when you have the **combination of your power and your wisdom** that you're using in your businesses, with your passion the way that I have, I used to just have to switch because men were turned off. Because I would be so excited I was on TV, I was flying around and I was

teaching women everywhere and men would look at me and go, "You're too busy!!"

You have to **look at how you're coming across to men** when you're on the first or second date. It is okay to be powerful, it is okay and amazing that you're doing a dynamic leaderful things in the world like you are. Like I was, I was a pioneer of the first speed dating company, I was running all over the place and my mother would say, "What the hell are you doing, **you gotta slow your ass down.**"

Women, I think they think that men are going to be like coming to the rescue when **men want us to be nurturing them**. Look how men think, ladies. I was one of the very first coaches for single men in America. This was 24 years ago. All women need to know is that most **men have not had "Prince training"**. This idealistic view that women think that men have been trained to understand the way we think. They don't. They do not.

**Gina:** We've still got women imprinted with the idea that he's going to arrive as Prince Charming on the horse.

**Renee:** Yes. Every moment, in every class [crosstalk] I go, "*Do you still have the little princess, the little girl inside of you dreaming of your prince coming?*" They all raise their hands or some of them go, "Hell no." [crosstalk] but what I say- ..... what did you say?

**Gina:** The big white wedding, the whole fairytale, it's a fairytale, isn't? It's not real.

**Renee:** When you think about your imprints as a child, my imprints were, watching everybody tell me I was going to have a fairytale and reading Cinderella and all the books. Little girls now have the same fairytale except it's in high def. movies with even more glam. All the movies show, women getting scooped up by a man, that's usually on a train, they fall in love and live happily ever after but they don't talk about what they do **after they went to the castle!!**

I'm here to give women the reality check that men want love, men are supersensitive about love but they have to put on this [broad?] out that, I know everything about it but guys, I tell you, I've been coaching men for years and now that the Internet is in place, **men are seeking wisdom about how to have extraordinary relationships** and they're looking for women that are smart, for women that are beautiful, for women that are dynamic but **they also want the nurturing and the love.**

The key to this whole thing is looking at how you are wired, what your love lineage is ... what's your love lineage ..... where did you learn about love, why did you become this dynamic woman? I became a wonder woman because I wanted to protect my heart, I didn't trust men. **Many of**

**the women in America come from broken homes** with mothers that were struggling and they decided very young that they were going to be independent and take care of themselves and they don't let the doorway of love open because of something, or many things, that may have happened to them or visions that they saw when they were younger. It's very, very important.

This is happening internationally. The American women saw their 50s moms stay home, have kids and then maybe get divorced and be left with no money, no career and they thought, "hell no, I'm not doing that, I'm going to go take my own money, I'm going to get my own stuff and I don't need anybody". We do need the balance of love.

**Gina:** That is a big driver, isn't it? If you've seen moms in her 50s, left for another woman and she hasn't got money because she wasn't able to earn because she didn't have a career, I suppose that's a big driver to go to make your own money and **make yourself financially secure**?

**Renee:** In my book, *Get Real about Love*, I tell my story of how I saw, not only my mother, but all of her sisters, all of the women had challenges and everyone would come to my mom's house. As a child I would sit behind the wall listening to my aunts all cry because their husbands left them for another woman and they had to work three and four jobs because they weren't college-educated. They would say to me, I was only five, you better get your money and you better save your money because you're going to get left.

I never wanted to have children and I became an entrepreneur. I was selling lemonade when I was eight years old and I worked from that age all the way through and I had a wall. Some of these women in America have imprints in their hearts, their unconscious that **keep them protective from opening their hearts to love**. What I call it is integration between the little girl that's innocent, that is still dying and praying for love and then the dynamic, other half of you that is fighting you from doing that.

If you don't get your two sides of you integrated and heal those imprints, you will going in a, what I call my book, love loop where you will attract, lovers, temporarily men that seal the void and then your years and years go by because you always have somebody in your life but they're never really equal to who you are and then you're 40 and you're going, holy shit, I didn't get married, I didn't have kids and then you go out looking. Those are the women that I'm working with. I'm trying to train the young women, really young women and women that are looking at being 45 and having kids, men want women that are ready for that.

If you have a big company and all that, then go *I want to have a kid now*, I'm like, really? You've got to get real how you are coming across, get

real. That's why I called my book Get Real about Love! I wasn't real with myself. I got lucky. You've met my husband. I got lucky.

**Gina:** He's adorable.

**Renee:** I got lucky, I got very lucky.

**Gina:** So many women entrepreneurs, corporates, what's the best thing that women can do to unlearn this and get themselves in a place where they can be the kind of women that men need to have or **how do we work with men to get a deeper understanding of each other?**

**Renee:** It's really getting deep in within yourself and looking at your heart. **How do you treat your own heart?** A lot of these women, underneath it all have a little girl inside of them. I know I did. My little girl ran my love life and my Wonder Woman ran my career but they weren't aligned to say, we could find a guy that would love us, but why don't I slow down a little bit and stop wasting times with WOTs, **waste of times.** I call them temps, men that are handsome, men that are charismatic and busy as we are.

Sometimes I would attract myself to myself. Half unavailable men were attracted to me because I was still building and building and building and **thought I had to reach a certain level of success before I would find somebody like my husband.** In reality, he was doing the same thing. He was flying around the world for Oracle, doing sales in medical health fields and he still is ... but he is deep down ... most of those men are little boys themselves ladies. If you can tap into the way men think and that is what my book is about, that's what all my coaching is about, is how you, **we as women really have the power in our hands to lead men with our feminine power.** That's why when I saw what you were doing, I was like, I want to be on your show.

**Gina:** Great.

**Renee:** We are running the world now.

**Gina:** We **are** running the world.

**Renee:** Look what might happen with our president. We may have a female president. I'm telling you this whole Trump nightmare that everything that's happening in America, it's crazy. What I'm saying is, the power of women, if we can get aligned with the messed up parts of us and the Wonder Woman parts of us and heal where that imprint came from, that's what my whole book is about. It's very deep but it's also my story. I have literary revealed my whole nightmare of how I dated bad boys and unavailable men.

**Gina:** I'm going to put a link to the book on the Facebook page; we've run out of time Renee. We've had a lot- we've covered a great deal and we've got a
